Collage Activity

Learning Objective:

To encourage creativity, fine motor skills, and self-expression through collage making activities for children aged 3 to 5 years.

Learning Outcomes:

Collage Making (3-8 years):

Set out a variety of materials such as colored paper, tissue paper, buttons, fabric scraps, and stickers. Encourage children to tear, cut, and arrange the materials to create collages on a large piece of paper or cardboard.

Prompt them to tell stories or describe their creations as they work.
