Dramatic Play

Learning Objective:

To encourage imaginative play, social interaction, and creativity through dramatic play with costumes for children aged 2 to 8 years.

Learning Outcomes:

- 1. Children will engage in imaginative role-play as they explore different characters and scenarios while dressing up in costumes and using props.**
- 2. Children will enhance their social skills by interacting with peers, taking turns, and cooperating in collaborative play experiences.**
- 3. Children will develop empathy and understanding as they embody different roles and perspectives during dramatic play interactions.**
- 4. Children will strengthen language skills as they engage in dialogue, storytelling, and narrative play while acting out imaginative scenarios.**
- 5. Children will foster creativity and problem-solving skills as they invent and adapt storylines, characters, and situations during dramatic play.**
- 6. Children will build confidence and self-esteem as they express themselves freely and creatively in a supportive and non-judgmental play environment.**

Through dramatic play with costumes, children aged 2 to 8 years will have the opportunity to explore their creativity, socialize with peers, and develop a range of cognitive, emotional, and social skills in an engaging and interactive manner.

Dramatic Play with Costumes (2-8 years):

- Set up a dress-up area with costumes, hats, scarves, and props.**
- Encourage children to dress up as different characters and act out imaginative scenarios.**
- Join in the play and extend their imagination by introducing new props or suggesting storylines.**
