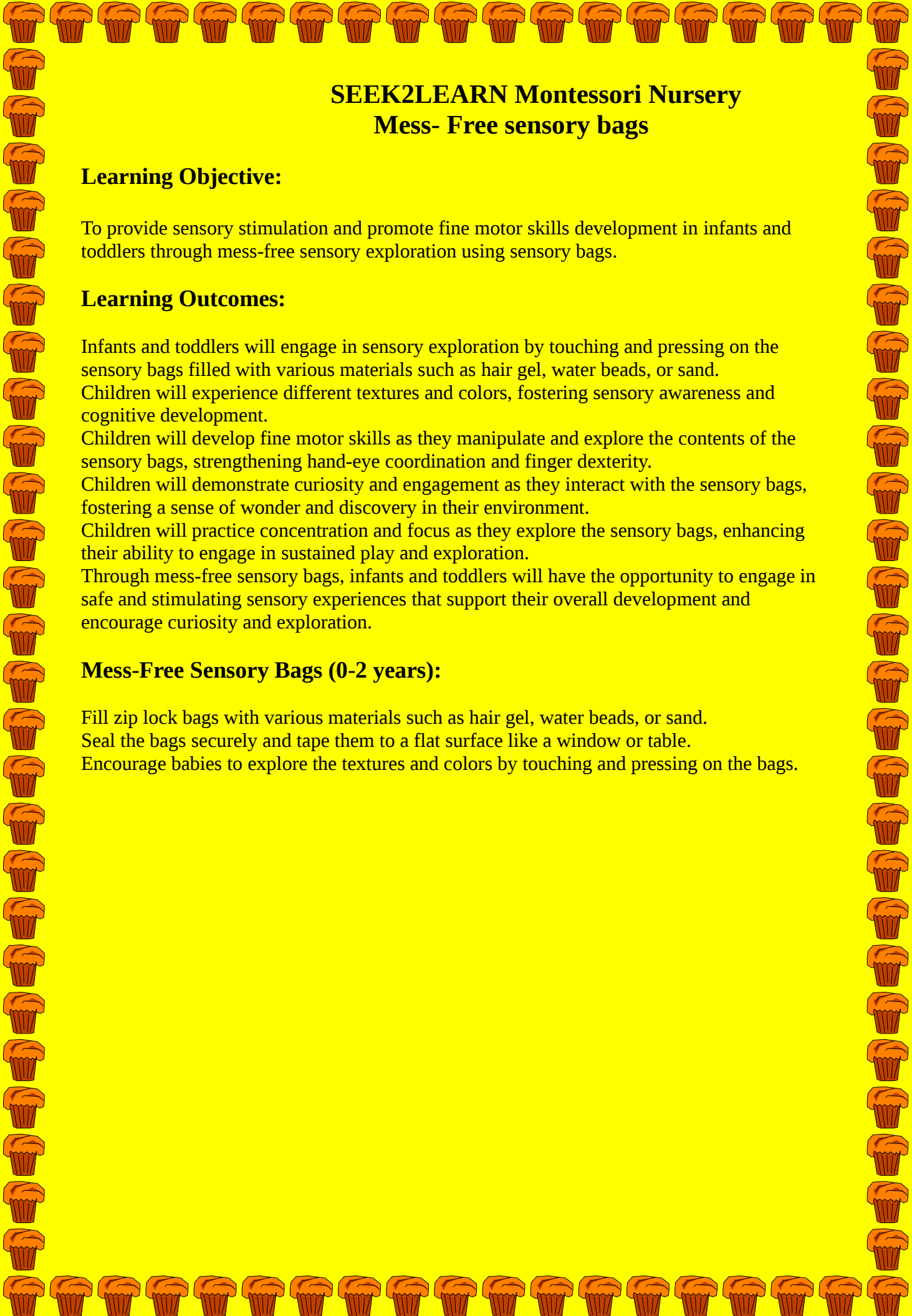

Mess- Free sensory bags

Learning Objective:

To provide sensory stimulation and promote fine motor skills development in infants and toddlers through mess-free sensory exploration using sensory bags.

Learning Outcomes:

Infants and toddlers will engage in sensory exploration by touching and pressing on the sensory bags filled with various materials such as hair gel, water beads, or sand.

Mess-Free Sensory Bags (0-2 years):

Fill zip lock bags with various materials such as hair gel, water beads, or sand.

Seal the bags securely and tape them to a flat surface like a window or table.

Encourage babies to explore the textures and colors by touching and pressing on the bags.
