Nature Art

Learning Objective:

To foster creativity, appreciation for nature, and sensory exploration through nature art activities for children aged 3 to 8 years.

Learning Outcomes:

Children will develop an appreciation for nature as they collect natural materials such as leaves, sticks, flowers, and rocks for use in their artwork.

Children will engage in sensory exploration by experiencing the textures, colors, scents, and sounds of nature materials during the art-making process.

Children will enhance their fine motor skills as they manipulate natural materials and use them to create artwork, such as collages, sculptures, and nature prints.

Children will express creativity and imagination as they use natural materials to construct scenes, patterns, and designs inspired by the environment.

Children will develop observation skills as they closely examine and identify different elements of nature, such as shapes, patterns, and textures.

Nature Art (3-8 years):

Take children on a nature walk to collect natural materials such as leaves, sticks, flowers, and rocks. Provide them with glue and paper, and encourage them to use the natural materials to create artwork.

Discuss the different textures, colors, and shapes found in nature as they create.
