Play dough activity

Learning Objective:

To foster creativity, fine motor skills, and sensory exploration through playdough activities for children aged 2 to 8 years.

Learning Outcomes:

Children will enhance their fine motor skills as they manipulate and mould the play dough into different shapes, objects, and designs using their hands and fingers.

Encourage them to use their hands to roll, pinch, and mould the play dough into different shapes and objects.

Enhance the activity by adding tools like cookie cutters, rolling pins, and plastic utensils for additional creativity.
