

Home Learning

Title: "Adventure with the Letter 'A' - Word Discovery Activity"

Objective: The goal of this home learning activity is to explore and collect 5 words that start with the letter 'A'. This engaging and interactive exercise aims to enhance your child's vocabulary while making the learning process enjoyable.

Introduction

Celebrate their achievements and creativity.

Extension Activities:

Story Time: Use the collected words to create a short story or sentence together.

Alphabet Song: Sing the alphabet song together, emphasizing the letter 'A'.

Letter 'A' Snack: Enjoy a snack that starts with the letter 'A', like apples or almonds.

Make the learning experience enjoyable and encourage them to share their newfound words with family members.
