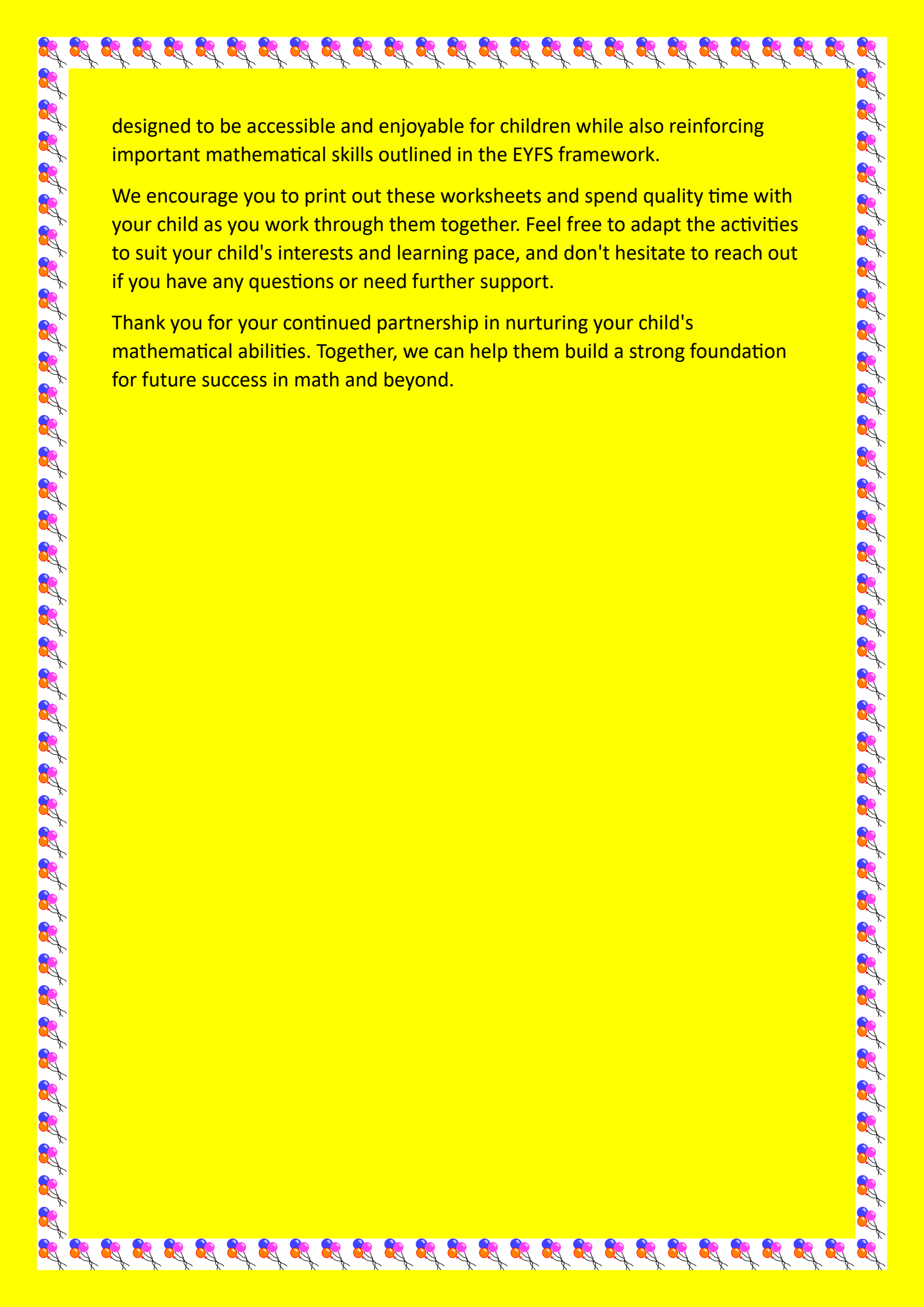
4. Money:
