Montessori activities – 3

1. Sensory Bottles (0-2 years):

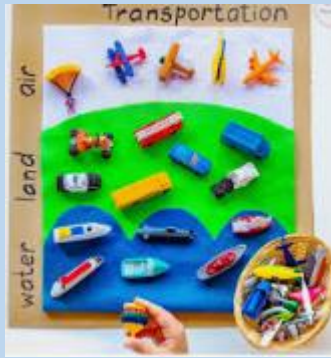
- **Activity:** Fill a clear plastic bottle with water and add a few drops of food colouring. Seal the bottle and encourage the child to shake it, observing how the colours blend and mix.



- **Learning Objective:** Stimulate visual and tactile senses.
- **Learning Outcome:** The child will engage their senses by watching the colours swirl and mix, promoting visual tracking and tactile exploration.

2. Sorting Activities (2-3 years):

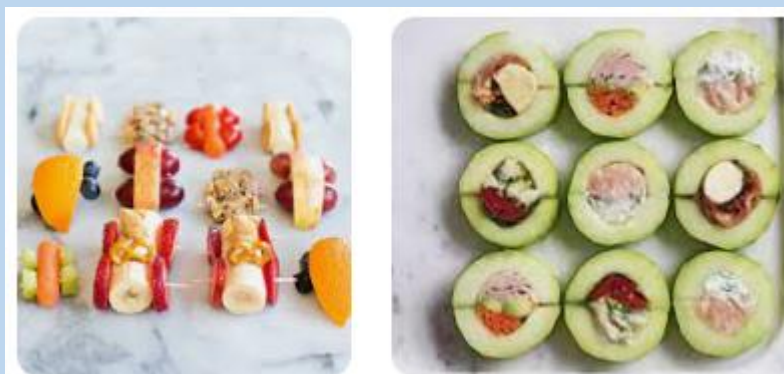
- **Activity:** Provide a collection of toy animals and vehicles. Ask the child to sort the toys into two groups based on whether they have wheels or not.



- **Learning Objective:** Develop classification skills and enhance understanding of object properties.
- **Learning Outcome:** The child will practice sorting and categorizing objects based on a specific attribute (presence of wheels), improving their ability to classify objects based on shared characteristics.

3. Practical Life Activities (3-5 years):

- **Activity:** Set up a simple snack preparation station with sliced fruits and vegetables. Encourage the child to make their own fruit kebabs by threading the pieces onto skewers.



- **Learning Objective:** Promote healthy eating habits and fine motor skills.

- **Learning Outcome:** The child will develop their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination while engaging in a practical activity, promoting independence and healthy eating habits.

4. Language Activities (4-6 years):

- **Activity:** Create a "word wall" with sight words or vocabulary words related to a specific theme (e.g., animals, transportation). Encourage the child to read the words aloud and use them in sentences.



- **Learning Objective:** Reinforce sight word recognition and sentence formation.
- **Learning Outcome:** The child will enhance their reading fluency and expand their vocabulary by practicing sight words and using them to construct sentences, promoting literacy skills.

5. Mathematics Activities (5-7 years):

- **Activity:** Provide a set of measuring cups and spoons along with containers of water. Ask the child to measure and pour different amounts of water into the containers, comparing volumes.



- **Learning Objective:** Introduce concepts of measurement and volume.
- **Learning Outcome:** The child will develop an understanding of measurement units and volume concepts through hands-on exploration, improving their ability to compare and estimate quantities.

6. Sensorial Activities (6-8 years):

- **Activity:** Set up a sound matching activity with pairs of objects that make distinct sounds (e.g., keys jingling, bell ringing). Blindfold the child and ask them to match the objects based on sound alone.



- **Learning Objective:** Enhance auditory discrimination skills.
- **Learning Outcome:** The child will refine their ability to discriminate between different sounds,

7. Nature Exploration (7-8 years):

- **Learning Objective:** Encourage observation and inquiry skills.
- **Learning Outcome:** The child will develop their observation skills and curiosity about the natural world while learning to identify different plants, animals, and natural phenomena.

8. Art and Creativity (0-8 years):

- **Activity:** Provide a variety of recycled materials such as cardboard boxes, paper rolls, and bottle caps. Challenge the child to use the materials to create a sculpture or collage inspired by a favourite story or theme.



- **Learning Objective:** Promote creativity and resourcefulness.
- **Learning Outcome:** The child will express their creativity and resourcefulness by transforming recycled materials into a unique artwork, fostering imagination and environmental awareness.
